

Figure 1 shows the SDD distribution by status of appointment. Contract of Service is the largest group with 61.43% or 180 employees (84 males and 96 females) and Presidential Appointees and Coterminous employees are the smallest with 1 (1 female) and 5 employees (4 males and 1 female), respectively.

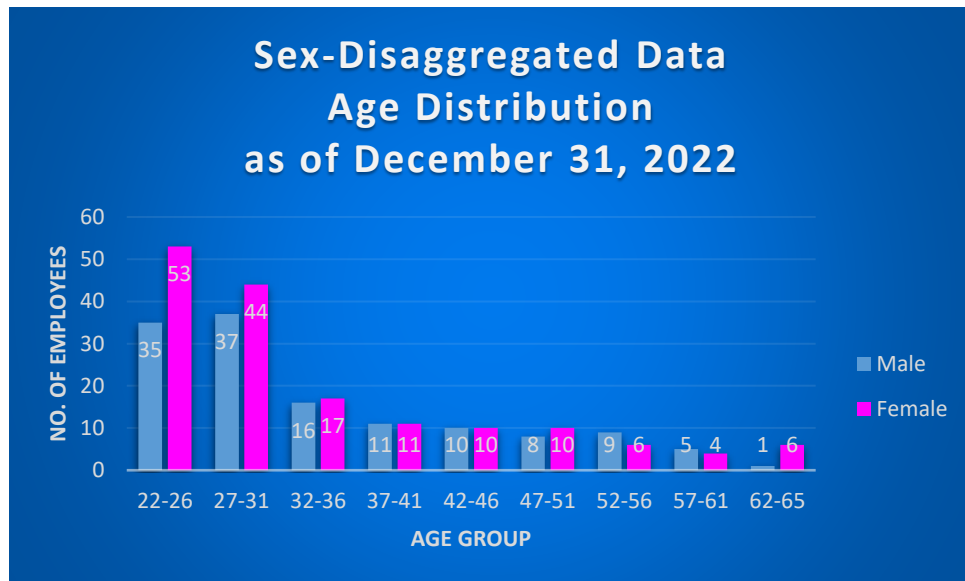


Figure 2 illustrates the SDD distribution grouped by age. The younger age group predominated the workforce of the Institute with 30.03% (35 males and 53 females) having the ages of 22-26, and 27.65% (37 males and 44 females) with ages 27-31.

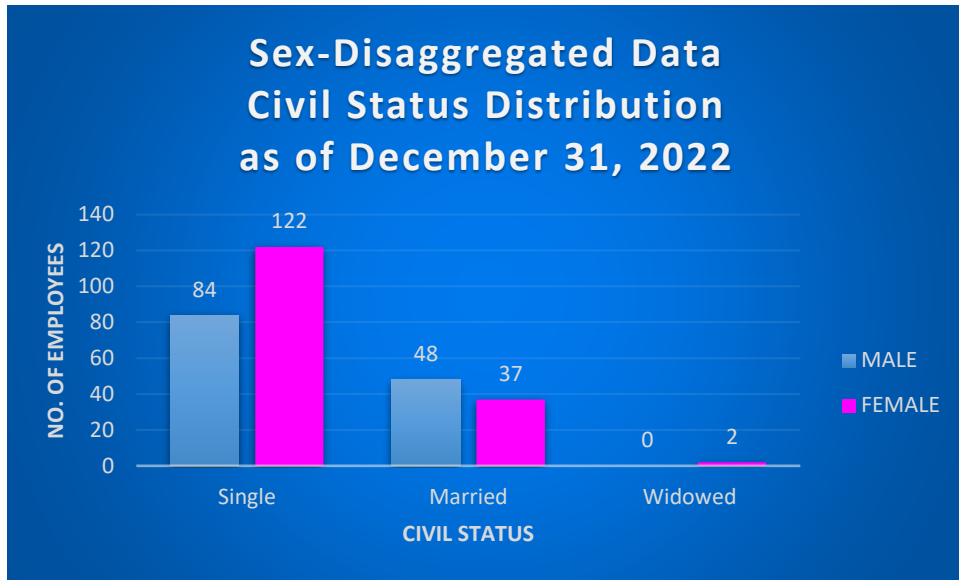


Figure 3 shows the SDD distribution in terms of civil status. 70.31% or 206 employees (84 males and 122 females) are single; 29.01% or 85 employees (48 males and 37 females) are married; and less than 1% (2 females) are widowed.

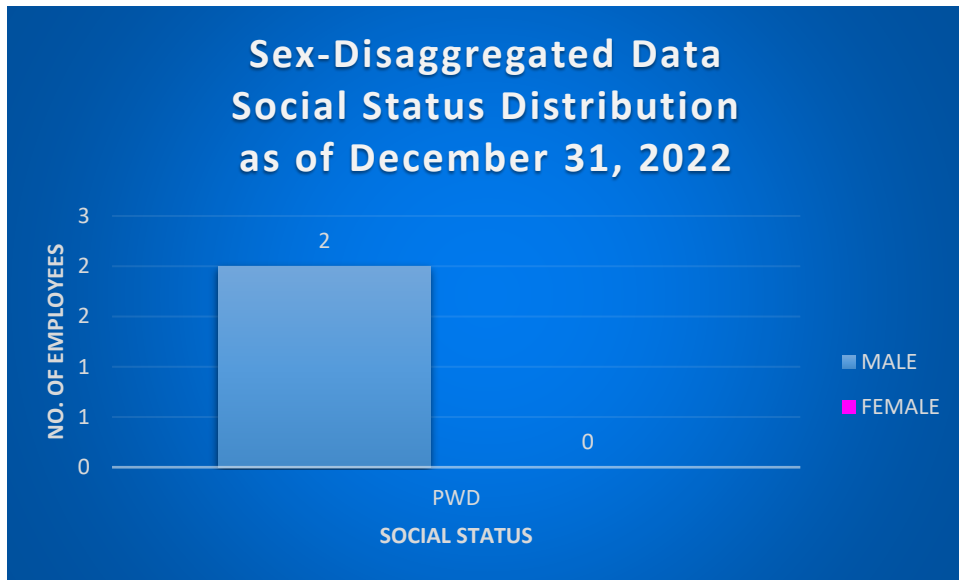


Figure 4 shows the SDD by social status distribution. 2 male employees are persons with disability.

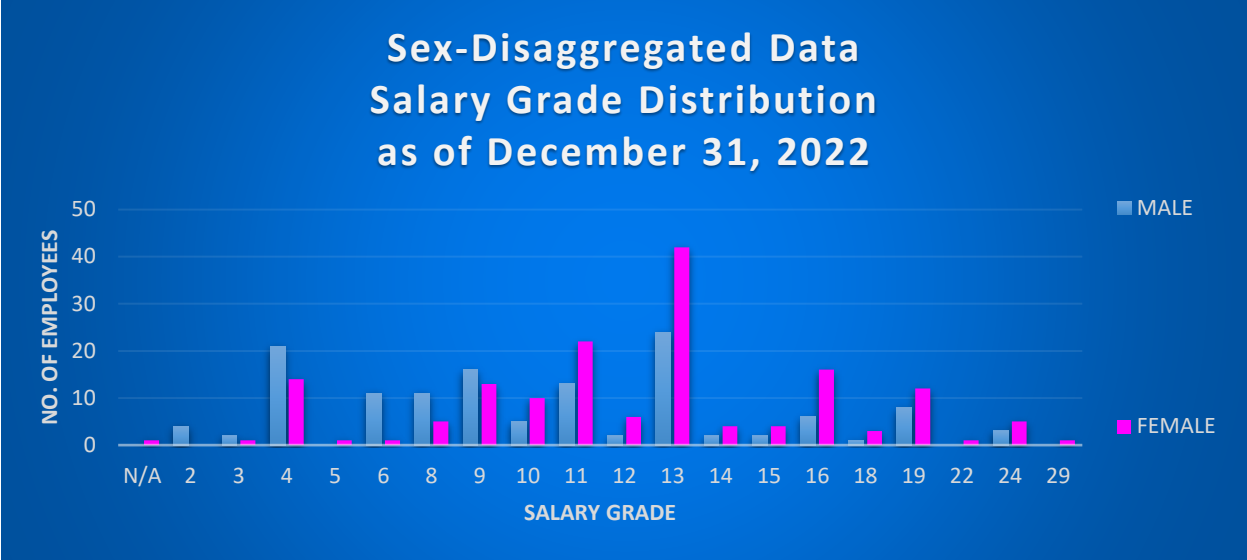


Figure 5 illustrates the SDD by salary grade distribution. All of the 2nd level positions (SG 10-25) has more females than males. On the contrary, the 1st level positions (SG 9 and below) have more males than females.
