A RESOLUTION AWARDING THE CONTRACT UNDER BID REFERENCE NO. RFB-WB-02 UNDER BID REFERENCE NO. RFB-WB-02 PROJECT ENTITLED "SUPPLY AND DELIVERY OF MULTIPARAMETER WATER QUALITY SONDE" TO DAKILA TRADING CORP. IN THE AMOUNT OF TWENTY MILLION EIGHT HUNDRED TWENTY-FIVE THOUSAND ONE HUNDRED SEVENTY-FIVE PESOS ONLY (20,825,175.00).

WHEREAS, the NFRDI Bids and Awards Committee (NFRDI-BAC) advertised the Invitation to Bid for the above project on January 8, 2025 through posting in the Philippine Government Electronic Procurement Service (PhilGEPS), in the Agency's website (www.nfrdi.da.gov.ph), and in conspicuous places within the Agency's premises for seven (7) days;

WHEREAS, the NFRDI-BAC conducted Pre-Bidding on January 16, 2025 presided by BAC Vice-chairperson, Dr. Joseph Christopher C. Rayos and attended by the BAC members, the BAC Secretariat, the Technical Working Group (TWG), end-user Myleen Magistrado, and five (5) prospective bidders from Dakila Trading Corp. Pro Maintech Consultancy, Inc., Chemisphere Lab Sciences, Cebu Far Eastern Drug, Inc. and Guill-bern Corp.;

WHEREAS, the NFRDI-BAC posted a Supplemental Bid Bulletin No. 3 on January 16, 2025, the amendment and additions on the ITB Opening of Bids, Section III Bid Data Sheet: ITB Clause 5.3 SLCC, Section VI Schedule of Requirements, Section VII Technical Specifications;

WHEREAS, the NFRDI-BAC conducted Public Bidding on January 30, 2025 presided by BAC Chairperson Dr. Joseph Christopher C. Rayos and attended by the BAC members, BAC Secretariat, Technical Working Group (TWG), end-user Myleen L. Magistrado, observer representative from COA and three (3) bidders: Dakila Trading Corp. Pro Maintech Consultancy, Inc. and Chemisphere Lab Sciences;

WHEREAS, upon opening of Technical and Legal Eligibility, the bids were read as:

Pro Maintech Consultancy, Inc.: Passed

Dakila Trading Corp.: Passed

Chemisphere Lab Sciences: was disqualified due to the PhilGEPS Certificate Annex A List of Eligibility Documents, as the mayor's permit had expired.

WHEREAS, upon opening of financial envelope, the bids were read as:

Pro Maintech Consultancy, Inc.: Passed and the bid offer amounting to Nineteen million Eighty-five thousand three pesos only **(PhP 19,085,003.00)**;

Dakila Trading Corp.: Passed and the bid offer amounting to Twenty million eight hundred twenty-five thousand one hundred seventy-five pesos only **(PhP 20,825,175.00)**;

WHEREAS, the BAC ordered that the copies of the Eligibility, Technical and Financial envelopes of the bidder be forwarded to the TWG for detailed bid evaluation and post-qualification process;

WHEREAS, the BAC- Technical Working Group (TWG) conducted post qualification evaluation on February 4, 2025, as part of the bidding procedure, following this evaluation, Pro Maintech Consultancy, Inc. was post-disqualified due to non-compliance with the required specifications;

WHEREAS, on February 17, 2025, the BAC issued a notice of post-disqualification to Pro Maintech Consultancy, Inc., and received their motion for reconsideration on February 18, 2025.

WHEREAS, on February 24, 2025, the BAC held a meeting to review the motion for consideration of Pro Maintech Consultancy Inc. After a thorough reassessment and deliberation by the BAC members, the Motion for Reconsideration was denied due to non-compliance with the required specifications, resulting in disqualification. Consequently, the BAC instructed the TWG to conduct a post-qualification for the next lowest bidder;

WHEREAS, on March 4, 2025, the TWG submitted the second post qualification report recommending the award for the Procurement Project to **DAKILA TRADING CORP.** as the *Lowest Calculated and Responsive Bid (LCRB) and compliant with the technical specifications required by the end-user*;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, that the procurement of the project entitled “**SUPPLY AND DELIVERY OF MULTIPARAMETER WATER QUALITY SONDE**” is recommended to be awarded for being the Lowest Calculated and Responsive Bid (LCRB) to **DAKILA TRADING CORP.** in the amount of **TWENTY MILLION EIGHT HUNDRED TWENTY-FIVE THOUSAND ONE HUNDRED SEVENTY-FIVE PESOS ONLY (20,825,175.00)**;




RESOLVED FINALLY that the Notice of Award be issued to **DAKILA TRADING CORP.**, for the preparation of the Contract Agreement, Notice to Proceed and commencement of the delivery of the goods and services.
